 The Rotary Foundation funding



- The system has been successfully implemented in more than 10 countries with different languages around the world with significantly positive research results
- It can be adapted to every language and culture
- It is inexpensive
- It is an integrative program that covers all educational improvements
- It covers all the needs to be solved in order to alleviate mass illiteracy
- It can achieve Literacy at functional level
